

POST CARE TREATMENT
FOR
CRYOTHERAPY /LIQUID NITROGEN
FREEZING TREATMENTS

Warts, pre-cancers or other skin lesions treated with Cryotherapy:

Swelling, redness and blistering may occur 2-24 hours after treatment. Vaseline (using a Q-tip) may be applied to the treated area(s) for a couple of days

Some fluid or blood-filled blisters will form 24-48 hours after freezing. If you experience pain or discomfort you may take Tylenol/Advil.

If the blister breaks:

Clean the area with soap and water

Apply Vaseline (with a Q-tip).

The blister will dry up over the next few days

If the area(s) become very red, painful to touch, and/or looks Infected contact the office 607-729-2777 to speak to your provider

Scabbing and peeling (removing partial or total area) will occur 1-2 weeks after treatment. Healing generally take 7-14 days with little or no scarring

ALWAYS wash hands before and after treating the area

Multiple treatments may be needed
